



Requirements Vetting & Rapid Delivery



Takes millions of user requirements and utilizes user-based prioritization to focus on the most urgent operational needs. Attacks those capability gaps and requirements with interagency stakeholders and only works those that are not already in progress somewhere else. Millions of user requirements are then vetted down to a core set of requirements that CTTSO focuses on and then turns those capability gaps and requirements into solutions as rapidly as possible.

Prototypes are field tested and delivered to the end user before the traditional acquisition process is fully engaged. Typically 18-24 months from the time the operational requirement is received; 6-12 month delivery on the short side.




Efficiencies




Over 100 Government Agencies
